In Nagaland, the Project has engaged local non-governmental organizations like ISRN to build vaccine confidence amongst vulnerable and at-risk groups that includes the elderly community. Vaccinated elders often act as community influencers and encourage many others to get vaccinated against COVID-19 without any fear of adverse side effects.
