In Nagaland, the Project has engaged local non-governmental organizations like ISRN to build vaccine confidence amongst vulnerable and at-risk groups that includes pregnant and lactating mothers located in difficult to reach, tribal belts.







The team worked on spreading awareness amongst the pregnant and lactating mothers about COVID-19 vaccination and assured them that it is safe for mothers.

With the help of persistent door to door visits and easy access vaccination camp set up as part of the Project, Nagaland's women have been able to fight common misconceptions and get vaccinated against COVID-19.
