The MOMENTUM Routine Immunization Transformation and Equity Project, supported by the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID), ensures equitable vaccination to vulnerable, hard-to-reach, and marginalized communities.

In Nagaland, the Project has engaged local non-governmental organizations like ISRN to build vaccine confidence amongst vulnerable and at-risk groups that includes pregnant and lactating mothers located in difficult to reach, tribal belts.
